Dear Parents//Carers,

## Year 11 December Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs)

Today your daughter received her PPE timetable and subject revision schedules, which departments have already shared these with students in lessons. We thought it would be useful to collate them together in a booklet to help you support your daughter, as she prepares for her exams:

- French and Spanish speaking exams will be held from **18<sup>th</sup> November – 27<sup>th</sup> November**
- Art and Textiles students exams will be all day on the **5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> December**
- All other subjects will have exams scheduled from **9<sup>th</sup> December - 17<sup>th</sup> December**

In January you will receive a report, showing the grades your daughter achieved.

- Grades 7, 8 and 9 are equivalent to A/A\* grades
- Grade 6 is the equivalent of a B grade.
- Grade 4 and 5 are equivalent to a C grade.

## Revision Advice

To support your daughter, we have spoken to her about how to build a revision plan. We advise she:

1. Follows a revision timetable at home, a blank template has been given to her. Ensure this timetable includes regular breaks and time to exercise
2. Plan and space out her revision, so she revises 3-5 subjects a day and revisits each subject 3 times a week.
3. Spends 5-10 minute reviewing her revision notes and quizzing herself from the previous session or week.
4. Make detailed *revision notes*, before she starts to deepen her knowledge for example by *writing summary sheets, flash cards, mind maps for topics, voice-recording her notes and quizzing*.
5. Tests herself through practicing exam questions and past papers.

Your daughter has access to **GCSE pod** - <https://www.gcsepod.com/> which provide a bank of online videos and quizzes to help her actively revise.

Students are encouraged to use **homework club** before or after school in **Room S18**.

Students should be regularly attending intervention classes at lunchtime and afterschool.
