

External Speakers

 Our pogram of external speakers talking about different opportunities for working in the Health and Social Care Sector continues. Below is a review of the programme written by Jahzara:

In today's lesson, I learned that a social worker needs specialized skills such as observation, active listening and resilience. We also discovered that everyone will use the services of a social worker at some time in their lives, and that they work as part of a multidisciplinary team. The role of a social worker requires them to make occasional visits to assess their service users. A social worker is a person whose job is to assist people in a specific area who are experiencing social or personal difficulties. We also learnt that The Mental Capacity Act (MCA) is intended to safeguard and empower people who may lack the mental capacity to make decisions about their own care and treatment.
