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Our course is entirely school-centred providing classroom based, practical training, underpinned by a weekly educational studies programme and Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) by The Compton SCITT. Trainees may opt into a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) accredited by our partner university. The course is full time over 38 weeks (term time only).

Training Route

We offer a Training Route programme for our secondary trainees. To apply for this course, applicants can apply directly to The Compton SCITT Partnership. If successful at interview the new trainees will be placed at one of our partner schools.

School Direct Non-Salaried

We offer School Direct Non-Salaried courses for secondary trainees. To apply for these routes, you will need to apply to The Compton School (as the lead school) and select the school you wish to be placed at for your training at the application stage.

Both the Training Route and School Direct Non-Salaried programmes share the same content. The only difference is the way you apply.
