Summer 2026 Public Examination A' Level & L3 Timetables, Contingency & Results Days

We wish to share some important information with you to avoid any possible issues this summer, with the forthcoming **May/ June 2026 Public Examinations Season**. After February half-term students will be given their individual exam timetables. Until then, please use these links to access all the Exam Boards' finalised summer timetables:

The summer written exam period for A' Levels and L3s will run from **Monday 11 May 2026** and lasts for 5 weeks (not including May half term holiday).

Please note that for the Summer 2026 exam series, "**contingency**" exam days have been arranged by all of the examination awarding bodies (AQA, Edexcel/ Pearson & OCR) which all students and parents need to be aware of. These contingency days for all levels of exams has been put in place "*in the event of widespread, sustained national or local disruption to examinations during the May/ June 2026 examination series.*"

The decision comes following the tragic events of summer 2017, namely the Manchester attack and the Grenfell Tower fire. The Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) have decided that they need the option to postpone an exam (or exams) in the event of an incident and rearrange them for a later date to allow all students a fair and equal chance.

The dates that have been set aside as the contingency days are:

- **Wednesday 24 June 2026 – all day**

This means that all exam candidates **must be available** to sit exams **from the date of their first exam until Wednesday 24 June 2026.**

This decision is not a school decision and does apply to all candidates in all schools, nationally. *Please can all students and parents/carers make a note of the contingency exam dates in the event that an exam board needs to invoke its contingency plan.*

Finally, the confirmed Results Day for all A levels and L3 examinations is **Thursday 13 August 2026.**
