Message from Head Teacher

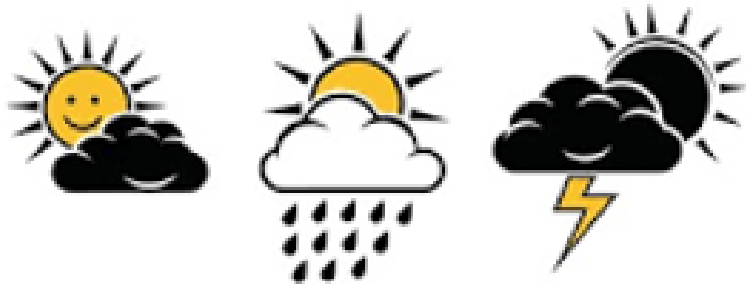
The weather this week has struggled to make up its mind what it wants to do after the very warm half term that was.

We will leave the lower site at 11:00am on Friday 10th of July. We will walk to Cineworld on Southbury Road, Enfield, taking advantage of the local cinema, which will not incur any travel costs.

The film starts at 12:00pm and the viewing will last approximately 2.00 hours. Students will make their own way home from the venue.
