Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers,

As we approach the start of the written GCSE exams, we are pleased to share with you the additional support we are putting in place for Year 11 students during their Summer 2026 public written examination season.

Lessons will continue as normal for all Year 11 students up to and including Friday 8 May. Following this, from Monday 11 May, normal timetabled lessons will end, and students will attend their scheduled exams and/ or optional final revision sessions.

What revision sessions are on offer?

The programme of revision sessions is at the end of this letter – the revision sessions are in green and blue, English, Maths and Science exams are in yellow, to show us when the whole year group are in school.

We have carefully planned these revision sessions around the examinations to maximise their impact on your daughter while minimising disruption across the school. Not every subject or exam paper will have a revision session; sessions have been scheduled where they will benefit the wider school community.

Can my daughter revise in school?

Computer Room S18 will become a dedicated Year 11 revision hub during the exam period. It will provide a supervised, silent space for students who wish to be in school during and between exams. Senior staff will supervise this area, and we will be encouraging certain students, identified as benefiting from additional structure, to take up this opportunity.

How can my daughter sign-up for revision sessions or the study space in S18?

From today, students will have access to an MS Form on the [Year 11 Team](#) to sign up for their chosen revision sessions and also to request access to S18. This sign-up will help us manage attendance and ensure that students are fully supported throughout the exam period.

Important information

If your daughter has an exam in the morning and the afternoon, and we have put on a revision session later in the morning for the afternoon exam (eg. Tue 12 May – RS and Biology P1), she will be expected to attend that morning revision session for Biology in school; she will not be allowed to leave school after her morning exam, and then return for her afternoon exam.

We will also be explaining and sharing this information with students during a special assembly today, Friday 24 April.

Thank you for your continued support as we work together to ensure Year 11 have the best possible preparation and support for their public examinations this summer.

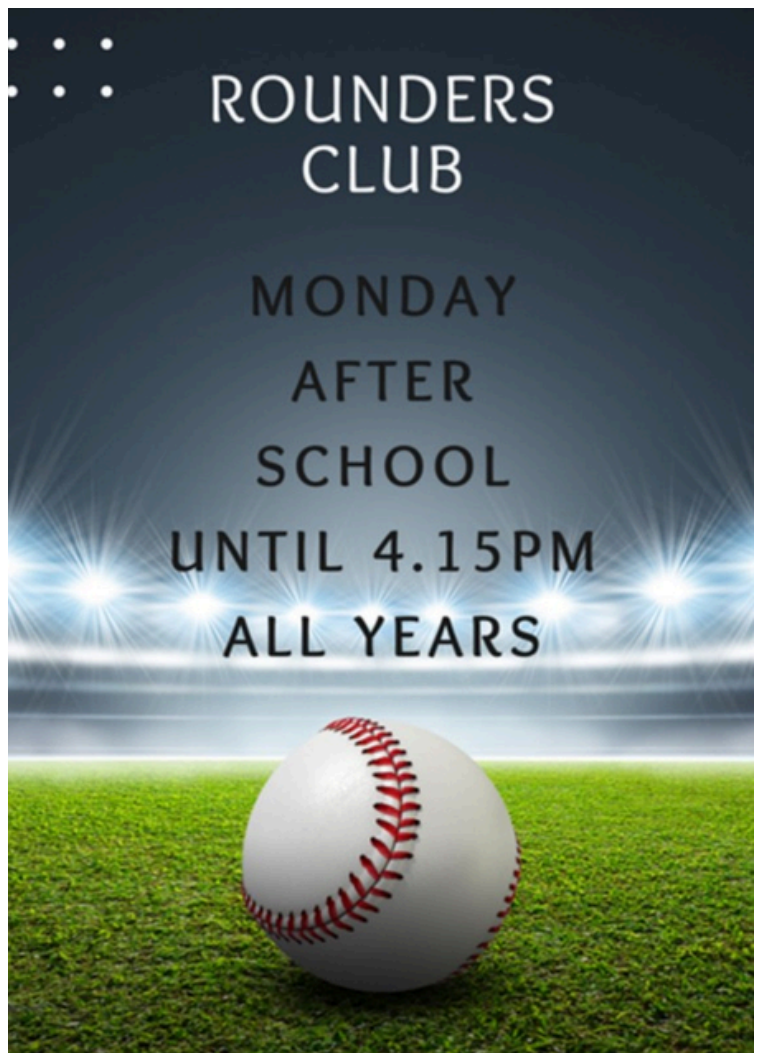
