- Plants

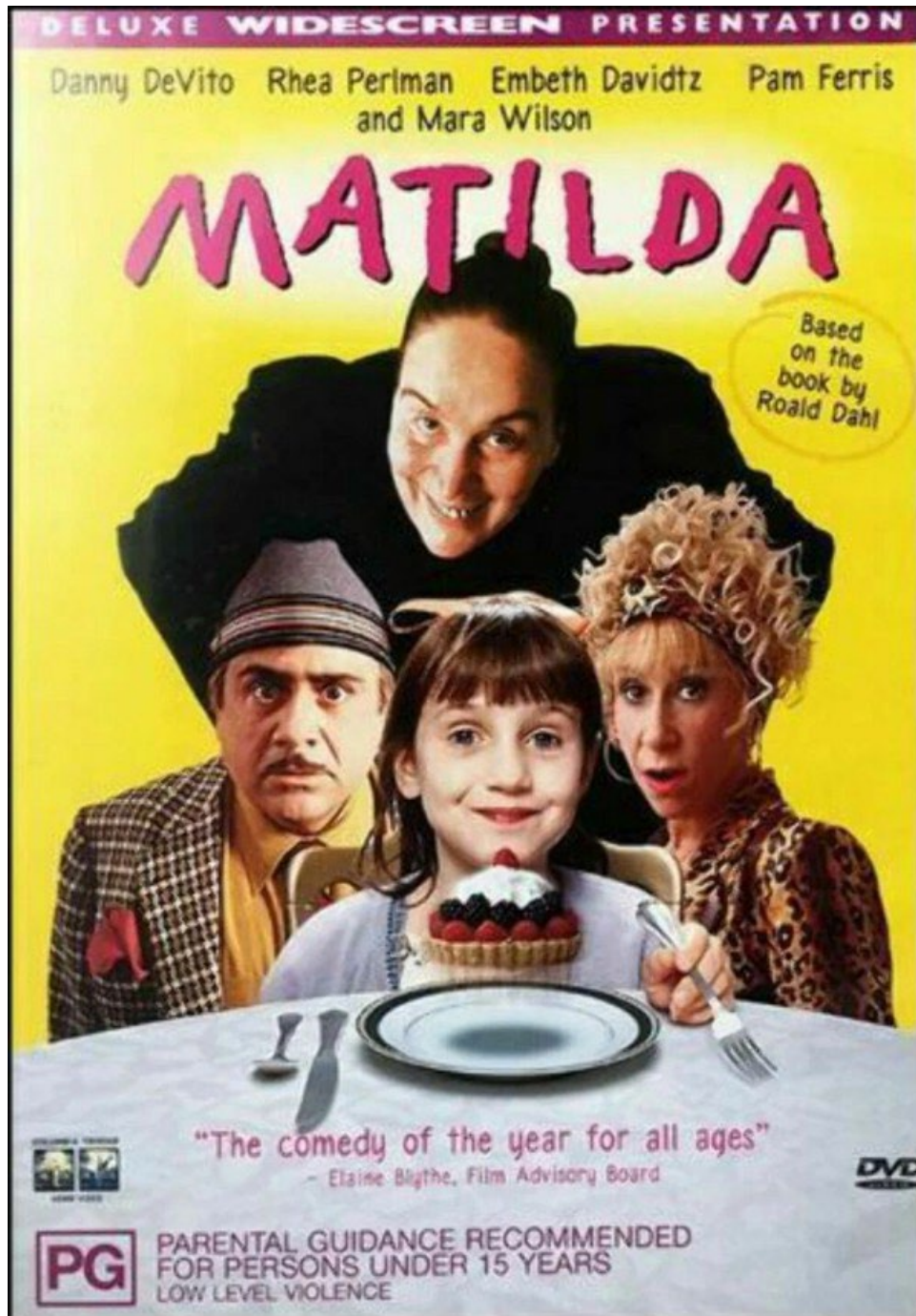
