It has been such a privilege to lead our wonderfully diverse, caring and warm school community and I thank you for entrusting your daughters' education and wellbeing to our school.

I am announcing my retirement at this stage to allow the Governing Body ample time for the recruitment process for my successor and will work closely with our incoming Headteacher to ensure a seamless transition and handover.

I thank you as parents and carers for the support and trust you have shown to me during my Headship here and want to assure you of my continued commitment to your daughters and our school over the course of the next Autumn term.

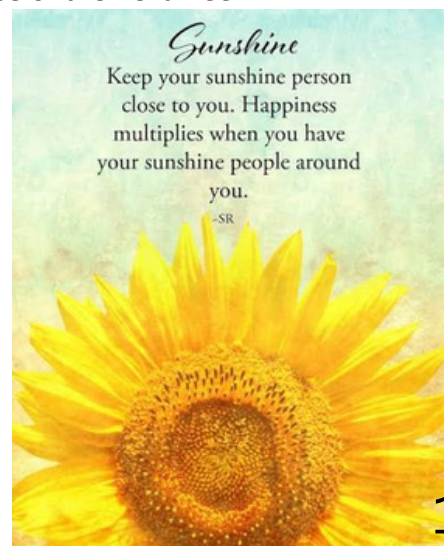
Until then, there remains a lot to do and to celebrate and I wish you and your family all the very best as we move towards our summer break.

Year 10 Pre-Public Examinations

Your daughter is sitting Pre-Public Examinations starting **on Monday 22nd June – Wednesday 1st July**. Please find attached a copy of her exam timetable, with this letter.

Attendance

Full attendance of the exams is expected. If students do not attend exams they will receive an **X grade**, as they would do in the public summer exams. There will be **no opportunities to 're-sit' PPEs at a later date.**

This provides a like-for-like experience for students of their public exams, where there is no opportunity to re-schedule or sit the exam at another time.

If your daughter is not feeling well during the PPEs, please send your daughter to school and contact Ms Smith, Assistant Headteacher, so we can put in place arrangements to support your daughter. We will ensure your daughter can still do the exam, even if it is in a separate room.

Punctuality

Your daughter must be in school by 8.30am, so we can start the exams at 9.00am.

If your daughter is late for her exam, she must sign-in at reception and report to the gym. If your daughter arrives in time to complete the exam, she will sit her exam on 'late desks' outside the gym to avoid disrupting the exam.

Students will also complete a late detention at the end of the day.

Exam Line-up

Students will line-up and be called-up to take their seat in the exam. Students are expected to be on time for both AM and PM line-ups, so we can ensure attendance is recorded accurately.

Equipment

Students must remember their pencil case and maths equipment, including a calculator, please ensure your daughter packs her bag the night before.

Lessons

When not in exams students will have their usual lessons, so should bring their full equipment.

Uniform

Students should be in full school uniform and must wear **a blazer** to enter the exam. If the weather is particularly hot, we of course will make adaptations to the uniform. However this is an important time for students in Year 11 and maintaining our high standards, including uniform, helps create the best possible learning environment for everyone to succeed.

We wish your daughters the very best in her PPEs. To support your daughter, **interventions** for Y10 have started at lunchtime and after school. We expect students to continue to attend in order to maximise their results.

I am delighted to inform you of Enfield County School for Girls Sports Day taking place at the **Lee Valley Athletics Stadium**.

On the day of the event, all students are expected to arrive at the stadium for **8:45am** and this is via their own travel arrangements, where they will be registered for the day by their form tutors. Sports Day will finish at **2:00pm** approx. where all students will be dismissed to make their own way home.

Students are required to bring a packed lunch for the day with plenty of water. If your daughter is entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch will be provided for her. All students are expected to wear **full PE kit** and will be given a house coloured bib when competing on the day. We suggest your daughter has lots of water and sun cream applied.

If your daughter has additional medical conditions relevant to Sports Day that the school is unaware of, please email ecsgeneral@enfieldcs.enfield.sch.uk and use this event as your subject heading.

We hope the Sports Day will be an enjoyable day for all students attending. Our usual expectations of excellent behaviour remain and any poor behaviour will be dealt with in line with our Behaviour Policy. If the behaviour of your daughter puts others or herself, at risk, then your daughter will no longer be able to participate and may need collecting from the event.

This event is not optional and we expect all students to attend. If students are absent on this day, it will be unauthorised. To encourage as many students as possible to participate in the events, students that sign up for either a track or field event will be entered into a raffle with the chance of winning a £10 shopping voucher.

Students will be given more information during a special Sports Day assembly after Half Term and they will be given time during ~~form~~ time to decide which events they would like to participate in.

Unfortunately, we will not be allowing spectators to attend on the day and therefore, kindly ask all parents/carers to not attend the Lea Valley Athletics Stadium to watch their daughter(s).

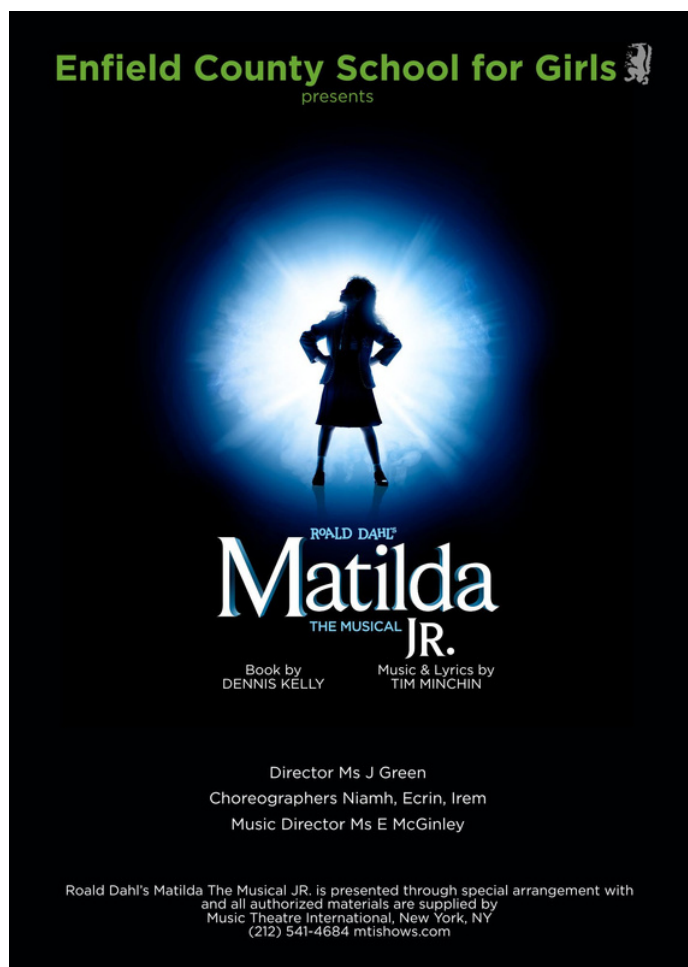
