Dear Parents and Carers of Year 7, 8 and 9 students

Rosemary Avenue - Parking

I am writing this communication for the attention of parents who drop off and/or pick up their daughter(s) at the end of the school day on Rosemary Avenue.

Rosemary Avenue is a busy road at the start and end of the school day, with our lower site and a large primary school located on the street.

This means that there are a lot of students and parents, often with very young children using the pavement area and crossing the road.

We have very clearly visible yellow school road markings with clear signage on two areas outside of our school to support the safety of our students and our local community and I ask that this is adhered to by all.

I have encouraged and would fully support enforcement officers issuing fines for irresponsible and unlawful parking on Rosemary Avenue and I know that local residents would appreciate this with cars regularly parking up on pavement areas outside of their homes.

Rosemary Avenue is due to become a 'School Street' later this year with restricted road access which will alleviate the unsafe congestion. However, in the meantime, I really appreciate your attention to this matter and encourage you to consider dropping off and picking up away from Rosemary Avenue itself.
