Baker Street Store

I am writing to inform you that from Monday 17 November, year 7, 8 and 9 students will be advised not to visit the local convenience store 'Baker Street Store' at 348 Baker Street, just around the corner from Rosemary Avenue on their way to school to purchase items.

The reason for this is that there are an increasing number of negative incidents arising from students behaving in an unacceptable manner in and outside of the shop. Sweets and other items are being brought in to school that conflict with our school rules; litter is being left around the school and we have late arrivals to school due to students hanging around outside the shop.

At times when the shop is busy, students have also reported that they have had negative interactions with some staff and we do not want our students getting involved in any arguments in this vicinity.

We will be focusing on the reduction of food and drink items brought into school that are not in line with our school rules, which may result in items being confiscated and your support in communicating this information to your daughter to avoid such a situation will be appreciated.
