## **Edmonton Green Library/ Conduct after School**

Dear Parents and Carers

We are writing to inform you of serious and ongoing concerns regarding anti-social behaviour involving students at Edmonton Green Library.

The library has become a regular meeting place for students from surrounding local schools at the end of the school day. While we encourage students to use community facilities responsibly for study purposes, there have been repeated incidents of unacceptable behaviour. These have included vaping inside and around the premises, fighting, and rudeness towards library staff. On a number of occasions, situations have escalated to the point where the police have had to be called.

We will be speaking to students in assemblies about these concerns and have made it clear that unless they are attending the library for genuine study purposes, they should not be going there after school. We will also remind them that by gathering in large groups and engaging in poor behaviour, they are putting themselves at risk as well as others.

Parents and carers are reminded that poor behaviour whilst wearing school uniform, even when outside of school hours and off the school site, constitutes bringing the school into disrepute. Such behaviour may result in school sanctions, including suspension.

We ask that you speak with your daughter about their conduct in the local community and reinforce the importance of behaving responsibly and respectfully at all times. We are working closely with the library and local authorities to monitor the situation and ensure the safety of all visitors.

Thank you for your continued support in maintaining high standards of behaviour.
