Y12 Parents' Evening – Thurs 16 April 2026 - Online Appointment Booking

I would like to invite you to attend our online Year 12 Parents' Evening on Thurs 16 April 2026, 4:00pm to 7:30pm. It will provide you with the opportunity to discuss your daughter's/ son's progress, effort in lessons and discuss the first year of their A Level, Level 3 or Level 2 studies.

Each appointment lasts for 8, 6 or 4 minutes, depending on teachers and numbers of students in the class. There is a clock that both parents and teachers can see that counts down and ends each appointment automatically. Once you've logged in on the night, you do not have to join each appointment; the software begins each one for you with the relevant teacher(s) automatically starting all cameras at the same time.

Appointments can be made from today and will close on the day of the Parents' Evening at 2:00pm; this is so that teachers can organise their confirmed scheduled appointments.
