Dear Parent/ Carer,

Re - School Uniform

This week all students are being spoken to at line up with regard to the standards we expect in terms of our school uniform; in particular regarding jewellery, nails, false eyelashes and blazers.

- Students are only allowed one stud in each ear, no hoops or dangly earrings and no other items of jewellery (except one discrete nose stud – not a nose ring) are permitted.
- Students are not allowed acrylic nails or nail varnish and false eyelashes are not permitted.
- Students must wear their blazers when walking around the school building. Hoodies should not be worn with the uniform. Blazers should not be carried around by students.
- Students should remove coats before they enter the building and must be wearing their blazers at all times this includes on the way to and from school.

From **Monday 9th October** any student is wearing acrylic nails they will be sent home to remove them. Any **extra jewellery** or a **hoodie** will be confiscated and either collected by a parent or returned to the student after a **week**.

Students wearing false eyelashes will be asked to remove them and if this is not possible parents will receive a phone call advising them that their daughter may be placed in isolation until the lashes can be removed.

This is an important time for all students in Year 10 and 11 and they need to be focussed on their learning and their subjects. We understand that your daughter is moving towards adulthood and may have a desire to express individuality in her appearance. However we are confident that her adherence to our clear expectations supports the best learning environment.

We thank you for your continued support and for discussing the contents of this letter with your daughter.
